- 3. Preparation of premises for the procurement/installation of new equipment;
- 4. Completed activities for dissemination and sustainability of the project for each university and work plan until May 2020:
 - work progress regarding the creation of PASO in each university, completed activities regarding the PASO implementation;
 - the state of the work about developed/completed questionnaires for interested in project non-academic partners, such as potential employers, local associations, representatives of industrial enterprises, other parties;
 - preparation of Bilateral Cooperation Agreements;
 - a list of events held to disseminate information about the project, including information about the training at TU Berlin in August 2019;
 - availability of publications in the press and the Internet, publication plan;
 - availability of information regarding the project on the university website;
- 5. Documents preparation for the payment of Staff costs for the first year of the project;
